About the EuroStrings Artists

The EuroStrings Artists are a selected group of young professionals, winners of international competitions, which took place at the various EuroStrings Platform member festivals. These artists are awarded a year-long touring programme, focusing on festival visits within Europe, following a carefully curated programme, including the creation of audience development opportunities – the EuroStrings Curriculum.

Giulia Ballaré released her first recording in 2013, Lirically Spain (dotGuitar) and since then has been regularly winning competitions. She has already won over 25 classical guitar prizes, despite her young age. She has been a D'Addario Artist since 2018. Giulia Ballaré has performed as soloist with Alessandria's Orchestra in Italy and Musica Viva's Orchestra of Moscow.

George Dimitrov – Jojo has already received high recognition as a young musician in Bulgaria in 2017 winning the Olga Kamburova Award at the Bulgarian Annual Ceremony "Musician of the Year", of Bulgarian National Radio. He made his solo concert debut with the Sofia Soloists Chamber Orchestra, conducted by Prof. Plamen Djuroff, in 2017.

Peter Graneis has completed a Masters degree at the Royal Conservatory in The Hague. He performs as part of Yehudi Menuhin's Live Music Now scheme and recorded his first CD, *Portraits* in 2017.

Dimitris Soukaras is presently a Masters student at the Royal Academy of Music, London. Among his recent competition successes, he won First Prize at the 2018 Mottola International Guitar Competition and Festival. Dimitris is also interested in music composition, especially for the theatre. Since 2016, he has been cooperating with the Theatrical Organization of Hillomodi at Corinth (Greece) and has already composed music for three theatre productions.

Radu Vâlcu began playing the violin but soon switched to the classical guitar, to which he has become devoted; this devotion has led him to win many awards for his playing, including 1st Prize at Volos International Guitar Festival, 1st Prize at Terra Siculorum International Guitar Festival.

Zuzanna Wężyk was born in Gdańsk in Poland where she started playing guitar at the age of seven. In June 2018, she completed her Bachelor of Arts degree, studying with the Marco Diaz-Tamayo at Mozarteum University Salzburg in Austria. She is currently based in London, where she is working on her Master's degree in Composing for Film and TV at Kingston University in London.
