About the EuroStrings Artists

The EuroStrings Artists are a selected group of young professionals, winners of international competitions, which took place at the various EuroStrings Platform member festivals. These artists are awarded a year-long touring programme, focusing on festival visits within Europe, following a carefully curated programme, including the creation of audience development opportunities – the EuroStrings Curriculum.

Gábor Hart has been working at the Szeged National Theatre since 2016, playing not only classical guitar but also electric guitar and sometimes even banjo. This varied background brings him success at international classical guitar competitions.

Peter Graneis has completed a Masters degree at the Royal Conservatory in The Hague. He performs as part of Yehudi Menuhin's Live Music Now scheme and recorded his first CD, *Portraits* in 2017.

Dimitris Soukaras is presently a Masters student at the Royal Academy of Music, London. Among his recent competition successes, he won First Prize at the 2018 Mottola International Guitar Competition and Festival. Dimitris is also interested in music composition, especially for the theatre. Since 2016, he has been cooperating with the Theatrical Organization of Hiliomodi at Corinth (Greece) and has already composed music for three theatre productions.

Radu Vâlcu began playing the violin but soon

switched to the classical guitar, to which he has become devoted, and this devotion has led him to win many awards for his playing.

Zuzanna Wężyk was born in Gdańsk in Poland where she started playing guitar at the age of seven. In June 2018, she completed her Bachelor of Arts degree, studying with the Marco Diaz-Tamayo at Mozarteum University Salzburg in Austria. She is currently based in London, where she is working on her Master's degree in Composing For Film and TV at Kingston University in London.

You Wu was born in 1993 in Lishu, China. After graduating from the Shanghai Conservatory of Music, he was accepted by the guitar programme in University of Music and Performing Arts Vienna, where he continues to study with Prof. Alvaro Pierri. You Wu has won multiple awards and has had a scholarship from Thyll Durr Foundation in Switzerland since 2015.
