About the EuroStrings Artists

The EuroStrings Artists are a selected group of young professionals, who are winners of international competitions which took place at the various EuroStrings Platform member festivals. These Artists are awarded a year-long touring programme, focusing on festival visits within Europe, following a carefully curated programme, including the creation of audience development opportunities – the EuroStrings Curriculum.

After winning First prize at the Tampere Guitar Festival in Finland, **Misael Barraza-Díaz** was the soloist in the première of *Viva Piazzolla!* a collaboration of Ballet Tucson and the Tucson Guitar Society at the 2019 Tucson Desert Song Festival.

Mateusz Kowalski has been winning prizes in international guitar competition over the past few years. He recorded his debut CD in 2018 with the Polish label CD Accord, distributed by NAXOS. He is also a scholarship winner of the polish KFnRD and Ministry of Culture and National Heritage programme "Young Poland".

The early studies of guitarist **Yuki Saito** in Tokyo included composition, French horn and double bass. Since 2016, he has been combining studies in Weimar, Germany with continuing success on the international competition circuit.

Dimitris Soukaras is presently a Masters student at the Royal Academy of Music, London. Among his recent competition successes, he won First Prize at the 2018 Mottola International Guitar Competition and Festival. Dimitris is also interested in music composition, especially for the theatre. Since 2016, he has been cooperating with the Theatrical Organization of Hiliomodi at Corinth (Greece) and has already composed music for three theatre productions.

Radio Beethoven FM in Chile described Emmanuel Sowicz as "the next star of the guitar" and he is proving that prediction to be accurate with his increasingly prestigious performances as a soloist and with orchestra at London's Barbican and Kings Place, and Canterbury Festival.

Julia Trintschuk was just four years old when she began playing guitar; at 16, she launched her career with a performance of *Concierto de Aranjuez* for guitar and orchestra by Joaquín Rodrigo.

Radu Vâlcu began playing the violin but soon switched to the classical guitar, to which he has become devoted, and this devotion has led him to win many awards for his playing.

Zuzanna Wężyk was born in Gdańsk in Poland where she started playing guitar at the age of 7. In June 2018, she obtained her Bachelor of Arts degree under the direction of prof Marco Diaz-Tamayo at Mozarteum University Salzburg in Austria. She is currently based in London, where she is working on her Master's degree in Composing For Film and TV at Kingston University in London.
